FS1

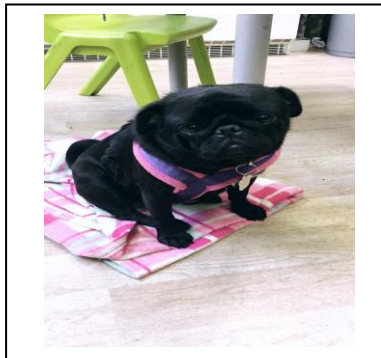

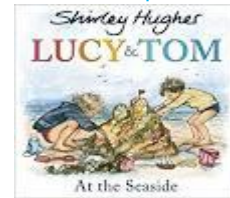


Y5
